



Hi, Parents!

We are excited for a great week of Super Kids Super Kamp (Tuesday, June 5th- Friday, June 8th)! This year, the theme of SKSK is "Mighty Warriors."

Our Kamp Verse is Psalm 20:7 (ESV) "Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the LORD our God."

We will be teaching this verse and jumping into the Bible to take a look at whom God is through judges Deborah, Gideon, and Samson. As we teach through the judges we hope they will discover these key points:

- God is faithful and we can always trust Him.
- When we walk in obedience to God we can have confidence and be bold because through him we have strength and courage.
- Jesus is our righteous Judge and through Him we are delivered from sin and saved from the punishment we deserve.

It is our hope that every child walks away from Kamp with a better understanding of who Jesus is and what He has done for them!

That is the heart of our Kamp, now here are some FAQ's:

What time does Kamp Begin?

Drop-off for Kamp begins each morning at 8:30am. On the first morning of Kamp, Tuesday, June 6th, please walk your child in the Fellowship Bible Church Atrium. After this you may drop them off at the east door. Each day your kamper will need to come into our atrium and check-in.

What time does Kamp End?

Kamp closing is at 3:00 pm. Each day you will need to come in and say, "Hello," to your child's camp counselor in the Worship Center as you pick your child up. We will have a Parent Celebration on Friday the 8th and this will begin at 2:30 pm in our Worship Center. We would love to have you join us. Kamp will end at the completion of this time. This is a great way to check out what your children have been learning and experiencing all week!

What are the Special Theme days?

Tuesday: Kids will be wearing Kamp shirts

Wednesday: Wacky Hair/Sock Day

Thursday: Water Day (Have your child wear clothes that they can get

wet in. Shorts and a t-shirt are great! Please make sure they do not wear

white or light-colored clothing, and have them bring a towel as well.)

Friday: Team Day (Have your child wear their favorite team shirt and/or other apparel.)

What does my child need to bring?

Appropriate Clothing that can get dirty or a little wet, a water bottle, and sunscreen.

***If your child will be going into 3rd-6th grade and signed up for Games and Sports, they will have a day that they will participate in an obstacle course on the church trails. They will need to make sure they have clothing that can**

get dirty. Here are the dates according to grade:

3rd Grade – Wednesday

4th Grade – Thursday

5th Grade – Friday

6th Grade – Friday

What will my child eat for lunch?

Every child needs to bring a lunch each day, please refrain from including items that have any tree nuts.

*This year some of our kampers have severe allergic reactions to nuts.
